Beads of Courage Drawstring Bags

Drawstring Beads of Courage Bag Instructions

- 1. Cut two pieces of fabric 9 inches by 12 inches to be used to make the outside of a bag. These two pieces will be called the focus fabric.
- 2. Sew a Beads of Courage label on the outside of one cut piece, in either the lower right corner or middle of fabric.
- 3. Lay the right sides of the focus pieces together. (wrong sides facing out)
- 4. <u>Stitch</u> a 1/2-inch seam on both long sides, forming a tube; set aside.
- 5. Cut two pieces of fabric lining 9 inches by 12 inches.
- 6. Lay the right sides of the lining pieces together. (wrong sides facing out)
- 7. <u>Stitch</u> a 1/2-inch seam on both long sides, forming a tube.
- 8. Using an iron, press open the side seams of the focus and lining fabric.
- 9. Clip corners diagonally at bottom of each sewn piece.
- 10. Turn lining tube right side out.
- 11. Place it inside tube of focus fabric. (The right side of the lining will be facing the right side of the focus fabric.)
- 12. Position the two pieces so that the seams of the lining line up exactly with the seams on the focus fabric.
- 13. <u>Stitch</u> around the top of the tube about ¼ an inch away from the top edge, joining the lining to the focus fabric. (*Using the open arm of a sewing machine works best.*)
- 14. Pull the lining out of the tube and press the seam towards the lining then tuck the lining back in the tube.

- 15. Turn the tube right side out, making sure side seams are kept open; press seams flat. (*This seam is the top of the bag. The open end is the bottom.*)
- 16. For making the drawstring channel, sew **2 inches from the top** all the way around the tube. Backstitch the seams. (*To backstitch, sew over a seam, then sew backwards over the same seam, and then sew forward. This extra stitching is necessary to give strength to the opening for the drawstrings.*)
- 17. Repeat step sixteen at **2-3/4 inch from the top** all the way around the tube.
- 18. At side seams of the tube, between the 2 inch and 2-3/4 inch row of stitching, use a seam ripper, or scissors with a sharp point, and snip the side seam stitches to make openings for drawstrings.
- 19. Turn the fabric inside out and press the bottom nice and flat, especially over the two side seams.
- 20. <u>Stitch</u> across the bottom of the tube. Finish with a zig-zag stitch to prevent fabric from fraying.
- 21. Turn the fabric right side out.
- 22. Pin a safety pin through the end of a 26 inch piece of ribbon or cord. Poke the safety pin through one of the drawstring openings, and gently thread it through the channel, leaving a bit out at either end. Remove the safety pin and tie the ends of the ribbon or cord together.
- 23. Take another 26 inch of ribbon or cord, and repeat step 22, this time starting at the opposite drawstring opening.
- 24. Tie knots at ends of drawstrings.
