Vic Wood will present a full day of woodturning demonstrations on Sept. 23 at the Powder Valley facil-Vic ity. is internationally recognized woodturner living Australia. He has taught all areas of woodworking for many years and has been widely involved in all areas related to wood. In 1983 he commenced full time woodturning, and has travelled England Canada. U.S.A., New Zealand and throughout

Australia teaching and demonstrating woodturning. He produces large pieces which are sold mainly through exhibitions, and smaller square-edged boxes with lids (his signature work) sold through galleries around the world. Vic will present an extensive range of turning topics including: hollow form, square-edged lidded container, bowls from green and from dry wood, chucking methods, sanding, finishing and more. 
A special thanks to Fletcher Hartline for his August 27th presentation on using found wood.

- harvesting the wood and how to orient it to yield the desired turned piece
- how to cut crotches and bowl blanks.
- how the wood reacts when turned green and then dries.


We are stocking the club library. If you have books, magazines or video tapes you would like to donate to the library please get them to Bernhard Voss or Mario Vitale.
