Ray Koeneman Presents Demo On Color Enhancement for July Meeting

Ray, a retired commercial artist with a lot of experience using an airbrush, was kind enough to give the demonstration for the July meeting. He began with the color chart and reminded observers how to mix the three primary colors to achieve any desired color. He suggested using acrylic dyes or refills from color printers and recommended not using black, as it muddies the colors. Ray demonstrated applying color by paint brush (top, right) and airbrush (bottom left) to enhance and make more permanent the fungal stain that appears often in box elder. Before applying to your wood, he recommends testing the color out on a scrap of poster board or cardboard. When using multiple colors, Frisk film works well for masking on wood, as shown in the top left image.

For those interested in purchasing air brushing equipment, he recommended getting a good, quiet

air compressor that will do 45psi. He suggested getting an airbrush with dual action controls. That is, one that will spray air and a mixture of air and color and allows a variable amount of color into the air stream. He suggested getting multiple, detachable cups so that you can mix colors ahead of time and switch back and forth between colors. He recommended the Badger brand because it has these features. Ray gave several pointers for maintaining an air brush: keep the tip clean using a reamer; keep the needle straight; maintain the condition of the threads by applying beeswax.

Ray said it was best to run tests on matt or poster board scraps before applying paint to the wood when using an airbrush. Misting after painting but before applying a finish, allows you to see what the finished piece will look like so that you can make adjustments, if needed.

Ray uses bleach to clean-up his hands and unwanted color on the wood.

August Meeting Demonstrations

Since Dave is out of town, Gary Hinegardner will present the pre-meeting. He will demonstrate cutting up a log with a chainsaw to obtain a useful piece for turning. For the regular demo, Walt Ahlgrim and Gary Hinegardner will show you how to care for green wood after it has been cut from a log and then how to treat a wet, turned piece, for example: bagging, microwaving, freezing, boiling. Lloyd Richardson will demonstrate the Wood-Cut Bowl Saver, a device that allows the turner to create multiple bowls from a single piece of wood.

Free Sandpaper will be available to all at the next meeting.

Elegant Forms Turning Contest

There may not be enough time to create a new piece for this contest with a submission date of September 15, 2009 but here are the basic rules. The turning may be functional or strictly decorative. Contestants are urged to define elegance for themselves.

Entries must be turned on a lathe at some point in the process and evidence of turning must be obvious. Only amateurs are eligible. That is, someone who makes less than 25% of their income from the sale of their work, teaching or demonstrating woodturning.

Entries will be judged by David Ellsworth, Cindy Drozda and Trent Bosch.

Entries are limited to one per contestant and must be sent as 3 to 5 digital photos along with an entry fee of \$15. Prizes include \$500, \$250, \$100 and \$25 gift certificates.
