Demonstration

Chris demonstrated turning a Frisbee. He first tried to turn a piece of solid wood strips, which had been glued together. That did not work out well, because the piece weakened as he turned it thinner. The piece was fragile along the grain lines.

Chris made a second attempt using birch plywood. It worked much better because it did not have voids and the cross-laid plies supported each other.

Remember, next month is our club picnic, which will include two Frisbee contests, with prizes.

The first contest will be a vote for the best Frisbee. The criteria will be whatever the person voting chooses. The Frisbee with the most votes wins.

The second contest will be for accuracy in throwing. It will be very similar to playing horse shoes. The space between the pins will be determined by how much space we have next to the picnic shelter.

You may use a different Frisbee for each contest.

In the event of a disagreement, the Board will make the final decision concerning the winning contestants.
