

Pre-Meeting



Using a tight grained wood makes it much easier to keep a smooth outside edge. This is a relatively quick project and it would be easy to involve children in making it. They could get involved by decorating the trees in a variety of ways.



Demonstration

Herb Bilgram turned a Christmas Ornament in the, "Inside Out" style. Remember to label the pieces before you separate them. Also remember, you do not need to glue the entire length of the pieces. You only need to glue about 1/2 inch of the ends.

This style allows quite a bit of creativity. It looks like quite a bit of fun to learn.
